New Initiatives Created from Adjustments to Pandemic

2020 is certainly a year nobody will ever forget – we have all had to learn to adapt to new ways of doing things and routine actions have had to change to support social distancing recommendations and initiatives to keep people safe and healthy.

As we have continued to provide services throughout the entire pandemic, we have also had to adjust some of our operations and throughout the process, have developed creative initiatives to help our

communities. Some of these initiatives have even caught the eye of our national association, the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging (n4a), that has shared the ideas with other AAAs throughout the nation as examples of creative ways to continue conducting business through the pandemic. New initiatives created from adjustments to the pandemic include:

<u>"Porch Talk" Telephone Contact Program</u> - Have you or someone you know felt more lonely or isolated during the pandemic and would like to chat with someone on the phone for some company and conversation? Our Agency recently developed a program to provide telephone reassurance for those who would like just that – someone to call them for a little chat and to perhaps assist with determining resources in their community that are available to help them with any needs they may have. There is no eligibility or fee for the service. <u>Caregiver Telephone Support Group</u> - The Caregiver Telephone Support Group is available for caregivers age 18 and older who are providing assistance for relatives, friends, neighbors, or others; but are unpaid for the services. This also includes grandparents or other relatives raising children.



Wellness Classes Resume...Over the Phone

Wellness classes provided by the Area Agency on Aging District 7 (AAA7) have started back up after a time off due to the coronavirus pandemic. While physical distancing requirements remain in place, a creative solution to offer the programs has been developed.

At the end of June, the AAA7 began a Diabetes Self-Mangement Program over the phone and beginning on July 21st, the AAA7 will offer a Chronic Pain Self-Management Program through the same way. The format will allow the AAA7 to connect and support class participants while learning valuable tools to manage their chronic conditions. Classes are held once a week through a 45-minute telephone conference call with AAA7 staff/class facilitators and other participants.

Those who are interested must pre-register for the class. Once registered, participants receive a free selfmanagement kit in the mail and the conference call information prior to the start of the class. Contents in the kit will be used for the weekly calls.

Residents 60 and older in Adams, Brown, Gallia, Highland, Jackson, Lawrence, Pike, Ross, Scioto, and Vinton counties are eligible to register at no cost. Seniors are encouraged to register to stay socially connected and enhance their self-management skills.

The AAA7 will be offering other wellness classes in the future using this format or an online format. In addition to Diabetes and Chronic Pain Self-Mangement, other classes include Chronic Disease Self-Management and Tools for Caregivers.
