State Budget

A preview to the State Budget was released by Governor DeWine on January 31st. Our Agency is keeping an eye on issues of interest to the populations we serve, including: an expansion of PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for



the Elderly) from one county to seven counties in Ohio; an increase in the Senior Community Services program which supports services such as meals, transportation and personal care; Alzheimer's and Dementia line item doubled from the last budget; \$4 Million per year increase in Adult Protective Services in the Job and Family Services budget; the Healthy Aging grant program which brings \$40 Million in state ARPA funds for Healthy Aging grants, which will provide resources to support older Ohioans in their communities; and an investment in provider rate increases to help address the current healthcare workforce shortages to ensure greater system stability and access to care for Medicaid recipients. We will continue to monitor and advocate for the individuals and families we serve to help support safe and healthy living in their homes and communities.
